Please make sure that your child's bag is clearly labelled with their name on the outside. A rucksack or drawstring bag is ideal.

2 Year Old Bag

- Nappies (a pack full which you can label). Your key person will tell you when it is running low.
- Nappy sacks
- Baby wipes
- Sudacream (if necessary and you will need to fill a consent form in)
- Spare tops, bottom, socks and vests:
 - o In the winter, hat, scarf and gloves
 - o and in the summer, sun hat, sun cream and long sleeved thin tops.

3 Year Old Bag

- Spare tops, bottoms, socks and vests
- In the winter:
 - hat, scarf, gloves
 - $\circ~$ and in the summer sun hat, suncream and long sleeved thin tops

Snacks and drinks:

We provide water and healthy snacks in the morning and afternoon sessions, so you do not need to provide this. Water is accessible throughout the session so please do not give your child a bottle to bring to playgroup.

Clothing

Please make sure that all your child's clothing is <u>clearly labelled</u>, we have a lot of children and it can be difficult to find their clothes. We do our very best to make sure your child goes home with everything they came with, but we cannot guarantee that an item may not go missing. Therefore please do not send your child into nursery in designer/expensive clothing, instead put them in the playgroup uniform:

- Black elasticated trousers/ tracksuit bottoms
- White t-shirt
- Red jumper/cardigan
- Trainers with Velcro or pumps. Please do not put your child in sandals, crocs or slippers as these can cause accidents when they are running around.
- Please make sure your child has a coat to wear everyday as we will go out in all weathers



When your child is ready to start toilet training please speak to your key person. We will be able to support you at the playgroup, however you must be doing the toilet training at home as well. You will need to bring in:

- Extra pants (as many as possible)
- Extra trousers
- Extra socks
- Extra shoes

We will put the wet/dirty items in a bag for you to take home as we do not have the facilities to wash them at the nursery. During this time is vital that your child wears clothes that are easy to take on and off – ideally the playgroup uniform. Please do not put them:

- trousers with belts and lots of buttons
- dungarees
- vests with poppers
- tights

All of these items take too long to undo if your child is in a rush to go to the toilet and they may have an accident before we can help them.
