

HOW WE ARE MANAGING DURING COVID-19

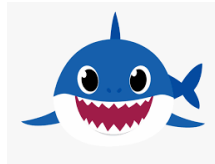
Caring Adults in small groups

During the coronavirus it is more important than ever that children have caring and supportive adults who are responsive to their emotional needs as well as their education. Here at Play2Learn our staff are very experienced in supporting young children and they spend time talking to them and finding out what their interests are.



Bubble Working

At the moment we are bubble working where one adult will stay with your child and their small key group every time your child attends. This is not very different from the keyperson system we have always used. This allows us to build even closer bonds with your child and build on what they already know.



Staying healthy

We are cleaning the nursery frequently throughout the day and have a member of staff responsible for this. This is done so it does not interfere with your child's learning, however we do teach them about good hand hygiene and the 20 second rule of hand washing – all done to baby shark! Children's snacks and meals are served in their bubble groups and plated individually, if your child brings a packed lunch, they will be served this at the same time as the other children in their group. Please do not bring water bottles as children can pick up the wrong one, we supply water at the setting which is monitored by the staff.



Outdoor Play

We have always been a setting that encourages outdoor play by using our garden everyday as part of our physical literacy programme and we have a qualified Forest School Leader and assistant. At this time, it is even more important that children get to spend as much time outside as possible, therefore all children will be encouraged to go outside in their groups to take part in activities and let off steam.
